S1/S2/S3/S4 Athletics Championships – Sandown Athletics Track – Tues 7 & Wed 8 May

Additional report for Athletics.

We have had the results from last week's athletics field events. The results are not complete with measurements and performances for every athlete unfortunately; there are huge gaps on the distances and heights thrown results sheet, with only the overall points for the team noted. So, apologies if your child is not mentioned, the results sheets are out of our control.

For the S1 and S2 afternoon we have:

As mentioned in the main report, Violet was 1st in high-jump with a height of 1.20m. Alicia 1st in the javelin with a throw of 21.58m – just under her school record. Evie threw a very good distance of 9.93m in the discus. That's all we have for the girls unfortunately, but we do know the rest of the girls were all middle of the table in their respective throw or jump.

The boys' jumps had Stan making 3.84m on the long jump, Ollie 3.46m and Sam R 3.26m, with all 3 boys in the top 10. The triple jump saw Isaac S and Lucas stepping up to S2 level and competing with the older boys really well. Isaac jumping 5.98m and Lucas 4.54m. Really very good for their first time. The last jump we have is Leo making 1.10m on the high jump.

Throws for the boys, and we only have three distances. Cameron with his best ever throw of 13.92m on the discus and Aubrey just behind with 12.30m. Samuel managed a very respectable distance of 9.5m on the javelin; very impressive considering he only actually had 2 lessons on how to throw.

The girls' throws, and again only a few results on the final sheets. Melaina throwing the javelin 13m; she is improving all the time here. Bella C gets 2 results here, and one of them beats her own PB and the school record! Her shot distance was 6.09m and takes the school record by 19cm. Amazing work Bella! She also threw the discus 12.36m, a really good distance.

On to the S3 and S4 afternoon.

We only have 4 distances recorded for the S3 girls and 2 of those belong to Caris. On the discus, Caris threw 10.74m and the javelin 10.57m, with both actually putting Caris in 6th position. On the shot Maddie threw 4.89m and Neve 3.30m. Good throws from the girls.

We have a few more results for the S3 boys, starting with Raymond who we know had a 1st place in high-jump and long-jump. His high-jump was 1.50m and long-jump only 9cms under the all time school record with 4.62m. Excellent work from Raymond. We also know Henry took 1st place in shot and discus. But did he get near his school records? Discus was just under. He threw a hugely impressive 26.35m, less than a meter off his record. Shot? 9.52m! He beat his record by 17cm! Great work.

Also in discus, was Victor, throwing a PB of 20.09m. In javelin, Victor threw 21.73m, into 4th place. Brogan was just behind with 19.45m.



Finally, for S3, Austin H jumped 7.4m on the triple jump.

S4 results, and everything we have is inside the top 6. We know Ethan and Joe were 1st and 2nd respectively in high-jump. On the triple-jump Harry R jumped 6.8m and Tom 6.73m. Harry was 5th and Tom 6th.

Throwing events, and we know Nikita took 2nd on shot, his throw was 8.73, and 3rd on discus with a throw of 23.50m. Taylor just outside placings on javelin in 5th place with a 24.33m throw.

The final results we have are Rosie on discus and javelin. Rosie has her 3rd place medal for javelin with a 13.10m throw and she can add to that 12.30m discus coming in 5th place.

Some very impressive distances from both groups. Very well done to all. And another apology to those who were in a field event, and we do not have a distance or position to tell you.

On a final positive note, the S3 and S4 team came 4th out of 9 for the day. As mentioned in my last report, this is hugely impressive given our size of school and team.

Thank you all for your hard work and pushing on the day.
